- We were able to increase the number of children we could accept due to the donation of the new home in Lincoln. It's quite an asset to the ministry and quite a blessing to many more young lives.

Show-Me's methods of restoration offer more than simply a house in which kids live temporarily as they grow up. For over 50 years, children continue to find a safe, stable, loving home and family with layers of support geared toward their current and future success.

With the guidance of professionals, Show-Me creates an environment customized for each child to thrive, all provided from a Christian worldview.

### What kind of children live at Show-Me?

We consider any child as long as they are "safe" (not a threat to themselves or others). Our blended family setting is best suited for helping:

- Boys & Girls (Birth through 17 years)\*
- Children in the custody of grandparents
- Parent-child or sibling conflict
- Large sibling groups stay connected
- · Teens with education or social needs
- Kids with minor juvenile court offenses
- A child needing a new environment to thrive

\*Older children will also need to demonstrate a "willingness" to give the program a chance.



### Rescued & Restored: Jennie Hackworth

Restoration that spans generations

Everyone knows Jennie to be a confident, determined woman. It is a stark change from the 15-year-old girl who first came to Show-Me: a confused, heartbroken teenager, who was terrified no one might ever want her.

If her own mom and dad didn't want her, how could anyone else? This lie relentlessly echoed in her head. It had blinded her to the love her family had tried to give her since they adopted her at the age of five. Over the years, Jennie's doubt and anger spiraled out of control into a destructive cycle. Feeling trapped and unable to resolve this on their own, she and her adoptive family turned to Show-Me.

Show-Me was a fresh start. Removed from the tension, Jennie could deal with the problem, not feel she was the

problem. She felt free to be herself, growing in confidence and finding many new talents. "I was surrounded by so many people that took me under their wing and provided guidance, even if I didn't want it or feel that I needed or deserved it," Jennie stated.

That kind of unconditional love changed her. It was the voice of encouragement she needed to overcome the doubts, fears, and lies that once paralyzed her. She has dedicated her life to being an inspiring voice for other young lives. Since graduating in 1992, Jennie remained heavily involved with her Show-Me family. She has served



in many different roles at Show-Me and continues to volunteer wherever needed. "I always wanted to help kids see their worth," Jennie said. "I am able to bond with the kids because I have been there."

With her Show-Me family's support, Jennie has been able to heal the once severed relationships with both her biological and adoptive mom, which she deeply desired. As an adult, she met her biological father for the first time. These bonds continue to grow and flourish, bringing a restoration that spans past and future generations.

Active in her community and well-respected in her career field, Jennie is also a loving wife, a proud mother, and a doting grandmother. The world is a better place because Jennie is a healthy part of it!




